“Thunderstorms and flash floods caused chaos across Britain in the final hours of the EU Referendum, as commuters left stranded in London”

More than 400 emergency calls were made to the fire service. The Met Office issued an alert to "be prepared." The Environment Agency has about 40 flood alerts and 14 flood warnings in place. The flooding has caused huge travel problems with rail services cancelled and roads close. **Hampering people voting in the EU Referendum.**

Over 6000 lightning strikes resulting in over 300 emergency calls per hour. Thunder was so fierce it set off car alarms. Some homes reported three feet of water in their basements. Transportation reported many cancellations and some polling stations were forced to close.
