
Understanding Salvation

COMMON SALVATION:

Jude 1:3,

"I gave all diligence to write unto you of Contrary To What We Have Been Taught the common salvation." Jude Did Not Change His Mind NOTE Concerning What He Wrote About. 1. A "common salvation" was being promoted because "certain men crept in unawares" (Jude 1:4). 2. The Greek word translated "common" here is "koinos." It has been translated "defiled", "unclean", and unholy" in the following verses. * Mark 7:2, "defiled." * Romans 14:14, "unclean." (3x) * Hebrews 10:29, "unholy thing." 3. The problem was a "defiled", "unclean", "unholy" plan of salvation was running rampant among the churches. We are dealing with the same problem today.



NEEDFUL TO WRITE:

Jude 1:3,

"Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints."

- Needful, Translated "distress" three times.
- 2. When a Doctor's patient goes into distress that patient is in serious trouble.
- 3. Christians were to "earnestly contend for the faith."

BIBLE CREEPS:

Jude 1:4,

"For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ.

Bible Creeps:

- They were, "ungodly men" (V.4).
- They, "crept in unawares" (V.4).
- They were, "turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness" (V.4).
- They were, "denying the Lord." (V.4).
- They, "feast with you" (V.12).

PAUL WROTE ABOUT THE SAME PROBLEM:

Galatians 1:6-9,

6 I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ unto another gospel:

7 Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the gospel of Christ. 8 But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed.

9 As we said before, so say I now again, if any man preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed.

Accursed Is Not Hell:

According to Strong's Concordance, the Greek word translated "accursed" (anathema) has nothing to do with going to Hell. It was an Old Testament type of publicly exposing those who were doctrinally wrong by having their names "...hung upon the walls or columns of the temple, or put in some other conspicuous place."

TWO TYPES OF APOSTATES:

Jude refers to **unsaved** promoters of apostasy.

Peter refers to Christian promoters of

apostasy.

Second Peter 2:1

"But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, ("Bought" Trans. "redeemed" 3x) and bring upon themselves swift destruction."

("<u>Destruction</u>" Trans. "<u>waste</u>" 2x)

COMMON SALVATION = APOSTASY:

Over 100 years ago, Gipsy Smith warned about our new present day, common salvation. In his message "Repent Ye," Gipsy Smith said...

"I am afraid that in our zeal to get people into the kingdom or the church we have lowered the standard. I am afraid that in our zeal to get people into what we call the church, we have been more anxious about heads than hearts. In order to capture, we have compromised and lost. We have been more concerned about filling our church registers than we have about the kingdom."

INCENTIVE SALVATION:

Just like the business world, we offer an incentive to get people to say yes to our sales pitch. We offer the *incentive* of Heaven, to all who will simply pray a prayer. We ask, "would you like to know for sure that you will go to Heaven when you die?" Well, who wouldn't?

Jesus never, ever, offered Heaven as an incentive for people to get saved and neither did His followers. Heaven is a tremendous byproduct of salvation; however, salvation deals with our repenting of our sin against God. Man needs to understand that we need to fall on our faces and repent before God even if there were no such place as Heaven.

THE OLD CROSS AND THE NEW: (1966-54yrs. ago)

- 1. A new type of meeting.
- 2. A new type of preaching.
- 3. New Christianity makes no unpleasant demands; rather, it offers the same thing the world does, only on a higher level.
- 4. The new cross does not slay the sinner, it redirects him.
- 5. The old cross is a symbol of death.
- 6. The man in Roman times who took up his cross and started down the road had already said good-by to his friends.

- 8. We who preach the gospel must not think of ourselves as public relations agents sent to establish good will between Christ and the world.
- 9. We must not imagine ourselves commissioned to make Christ acceptable to big business, the press, the world of sports or modern education. We are not diplomats but prophets, and our message is not a compromise but an ultimatum.
- 10.Let us preach the old cross and we will know the old power. (A. W. Tozer, Man, the Dwelling Place of God, 1966)

D.L. Moody said, "I believe we are making a woeful mistake in taking so many people into the Church who have never been truly convicted of sin."




THE RESULT OF REPENTANCE. A CHANGE OF DESIRES:





4. HOW TO BE SAVED:


Acts 16:30, (Jailer)

- "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?"

Second Corinthians 5:10, (Paul & Silas)

- 22 And the multitude rose up together against them: and the magistrates rent off their clothes, and commanded to beat them.
- 23 And when they had laid **many stripes** upon them, they cast them into **prison**, charging the jailor to keep them safely:
- 24 Who, having received such a charge, thrust them into the inner prison, and made their feet fast in the stocks.
- 25 And at midnight **Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God**: and **the prisoners heard them**.
- 26 And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately all the doors were opened, and every one's bands were loosed.
- 27 And the keeper of the prison awaking out of his sleep, and seeing the prison doors open, he drew out his sword, and would have killed himself, supposing that the prisoners had been fled.
- 28 But Paul cried with a loud voice, saying, **Do thyself no harm: for we are all here**.
- 29 Then he called for a light, and sprang in, and came trembling, and fell down before Paul and Silas,
- 30 And brought them out, and said, Sirs, what must I do to be saved?
