Repentance is simply responding in a positive way to the Holy Spirit when we are convicted of sin

There is not a person in this world who is saved, if he or she did not repent of their sin when convicted by the Holy Spirit.

The Result of Repentance Is A Changed Life

Second Corinthians 5:17,

"Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new."

When a person repents, that person becomes a “new creature.” The Greek word translated “creature” here is ktisis. It has been translated creation six times.

When God created the world we read, “The earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved” (Genesis 1:2).

This is what happens when a person repents of sin. Genesis 1:3 says, “...and there was light.” Jesus said, “I am come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth on me should not abide in darkness” (John 12:46).

When a person repents, “old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new” (Second Corinthians 5:17).
