

Second Thessalonians 2:1-3,

- 1 Now we beseech you, _brethren, by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and by our gathering together unto him,
- 2 That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand.
- 3 Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there
- come <u>a falling away</u> first, <u>and</u> that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;

- 2. Soon "shaken" (Not Grounded) (V.2).
- 3. Easily "troubled" (Not Grounded) (V.2).
- 4. Lack of discernment (V.2)
 - a. "Mind" Translated "Understanding" 7x.
- 5. Deception (V.3).






Paul was accused of causing the Jews to "apostatize."

 - Missed "Promised Land" VCL

8 For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that ye shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.


